2. 將防護網固定在電機部

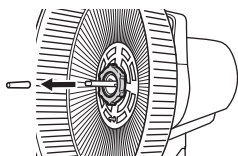
- 將電機部稍微向上，將防護網的圓孔置入電機軸下方的凸位
- 將緊固環（小）向右旋轉，確保緊固到位置



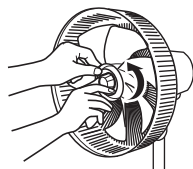
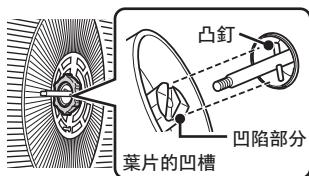

3. 取下蓋子，安裝風葉

- 取下蓋子。
- 將葉片的凹槽對準電機軸上的凸釘，對齊凹部並扣合。
- 用手固定葉片，向左旋轉旋轉頭，並以緊固手柄旋轉葉片，確認旋轉頭不會脫落。

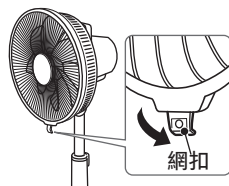
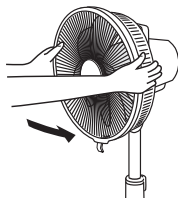
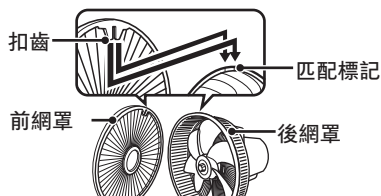

- 取下網扣，將前網罩的扣齒對準後網罩的「對齊標記」插入。
- 從前網罩上方將前網罩固定到後網罩上，插入。
- 使用網扣固定。



遙控器電池安裝

- 用手指滑動移除電池盒蓋。
- 插入 2 粒 AAA 電池，並確保電池按圖示方向放置（圖 1）。
- 按圖示方向滑動安裝電池盒蓋（圖 1）。

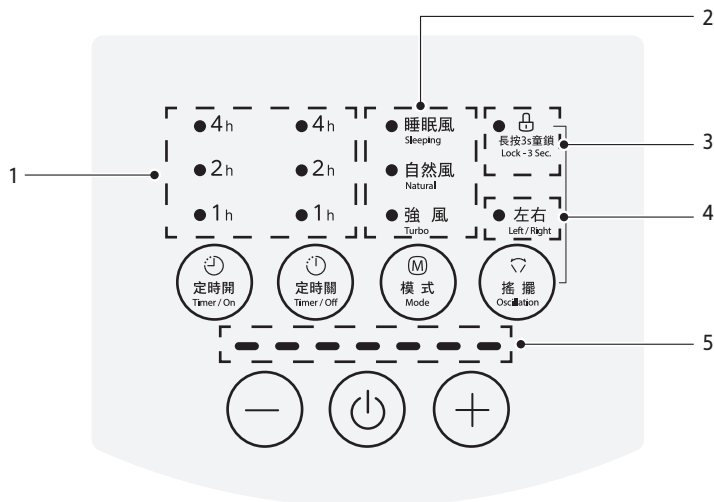
遙控器電池安裝

⚠ 注意：

- 遙控器使用 AAA 碳鋅電池。
- 請勿使用充電電池。切勿使用經過改裝或損壞的電池。

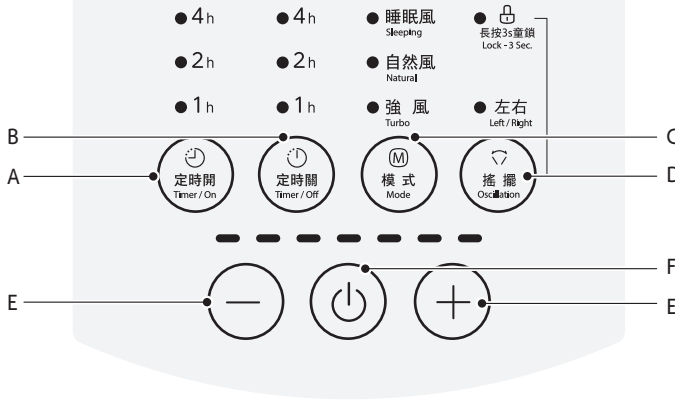

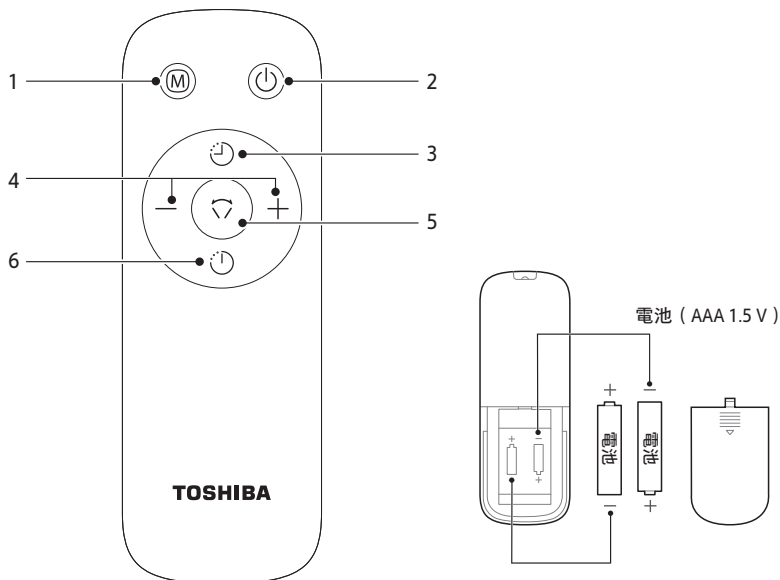

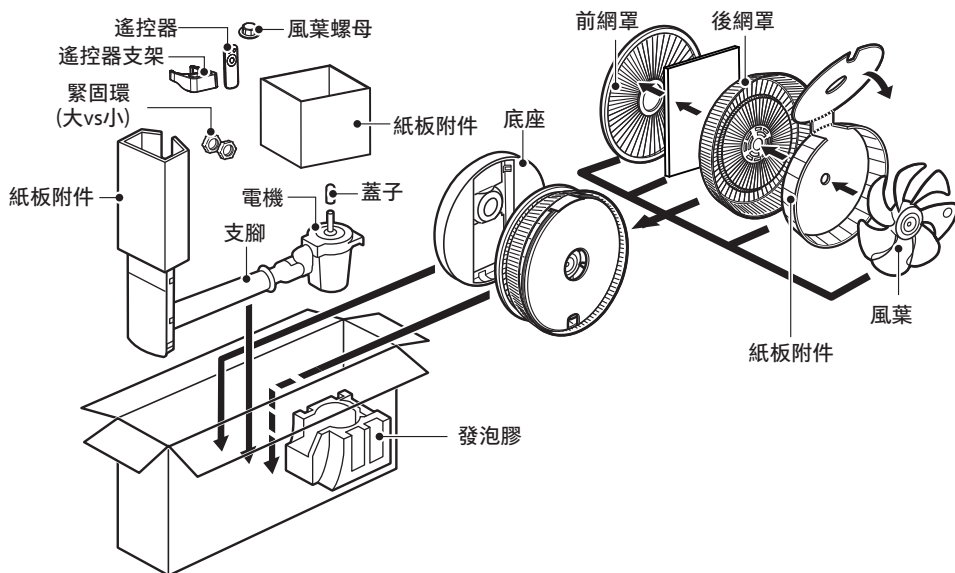

清潔保養

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

CAUTION

- Read Rules for Safe Operation and Instructions Carefully.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Never insert fingers, pencils, or any other object through the grille when fan is running.
- Disconnect fan when moving from one location to another.
- Be sure fan is on a stable surface when operating to avoid overturning.
- Do not use fan in window, rain may create electrical hazard.
- This appliance is for household use only.

WARNING

- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- To protect against the risk of electrical shock, do not immerse the unit, cord or plug in water or other liquid.
- When the appliance is not in use and before cleaning, unplug the appliance from the outlet.
- When the fan was assembled, the rotor blade guard shall not be taken off anymore.
 - Unplug fan before cleaning.
 - The rotor guard shall not be disassembled/opened to clean the rotor blades.
 - Wipe the fan enclosure and rotor blade guard with a slightly damp cloth.

- Ensure that the fan is switched off from the supply mains before removing the guard.
- **WARNING:** Keep out of reach of children. Swallowing can lead to chemical burns, perforation of soft tissue, and death. Severe burns can occur within 2h of ingestion. Seek medical attention immediately.
- Do not expose the appliance or battery to excessive temperatures.
- If the appliance is to be stored unused for a long period, the batteries should be removed. Do not use modified or damaged batteries.

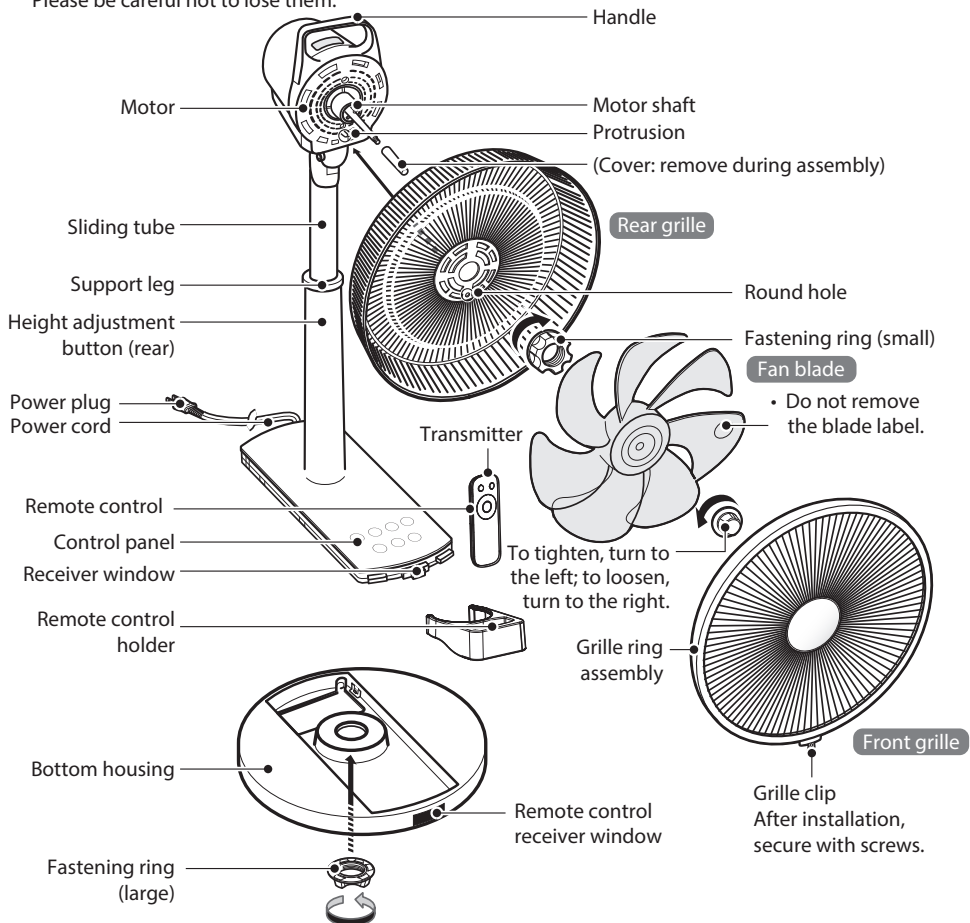

WARNING



FORBIDDEN

Operating without the blades and grille installed, or not pressing the height adjustment button (may cause injury).

Do not step on the power cord with the base (risk of fire and electric shock).



Unplug the plug

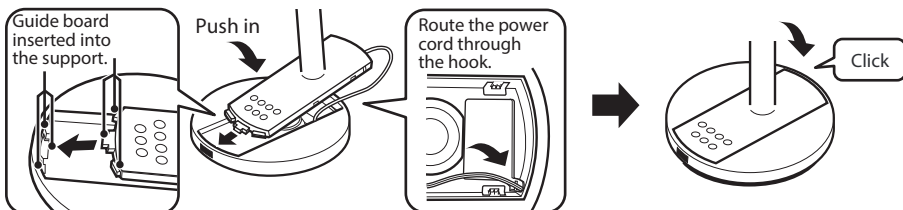
Unplug the power plug during assembly, cleaning, or moving (to prevent electric shock and injury).

The support leg cannot stand on its own. Lay the unit flat before assembly.

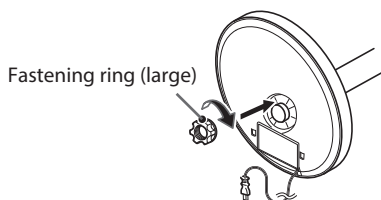
- When holding the support leg, please grasp it firmly with both hands. Holding with one hand may cause imbalance; the motor portion may sag and result in injury.
- When it falls over, do not apply any load or impact to the motor shaft. This may be the cause of the malfunction.

1. Secure the support leg to the base.

- Route the power cord through the hole in the base, insert the guiding parts (3 places) of the support pole into the guiding insertion holes (3 places) in the base, and attach the support pole.
- Please do not pinch the power cord or step on the base.



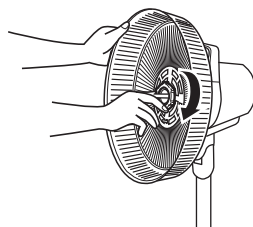
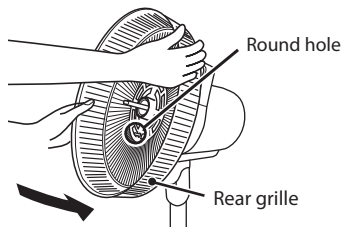
- Hold the pole and base with your hand, lay them horizontally, rotate the large fastening ring to the right to tighten it, and ensure the large fastening ring is secure.



2. Secure the protective grille to the motor unit.

- Lift the motor unit slightly upward, and insert the round part of the protective grille into the protrusion beneath the motor shaft

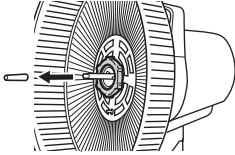
- Turn the small fastening ring to the right to ensure it is secured in place.



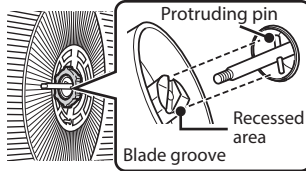

3. Remove the cover, install the fan blades

- Remove the cover.
- Align the blade groove with the protruding pin on the motor shaft, align the recess and snap it into place.
- Hold the blade with one hand, rotate the retaining ring to the left to tighten it, and ensure it does not come loose.

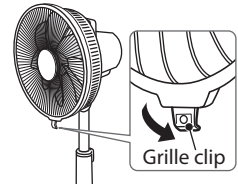
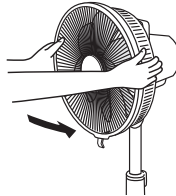
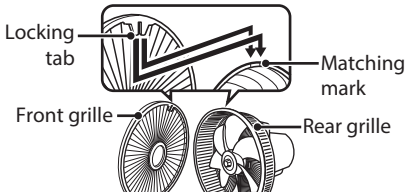


The cover is for storage.

4. Secure the front grille

- Remove the grille clip, align the locking tabs of the front grille with the "alignment mark" on the rear grille, and insert.
- Insert the front grille into the rear grille from above to secure it.
- And secure with the grille clips.



REMOTE CONTROL BATTERY INSTALLATION

- Slide the battery compartment cover off with your finger.
- Insert 2 AAA batteries, and ensure the batteries are installed as shown (Figure 1).
- Slide the battery compartment cover in the direction shown to install it (Figure 1).

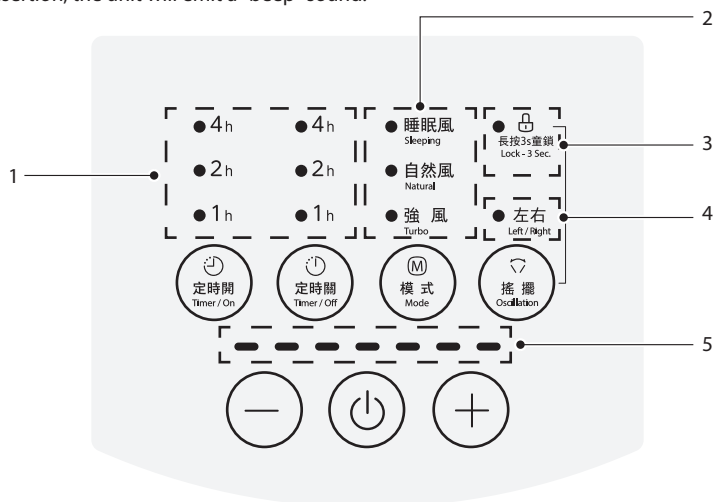
REMOTE CONTROL BATTERY INSTALLATION

Note:

- The remote control uses AAA carbon-zinc batteries.
- Do not use rechargeable batteries. Do not use modified or damaged batteries.
- Do not expose the appliance or battery to excessive temperatures.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Batteries must be inserted with the correct polarity. Depleted batteries should be removed from the device and disposed of safely.
- If the device will be left unused for an extended period, remove the batteries and avoid shorting the power terminals.
- Do not put the remote control batteries in fire; they may explode or leak.
- Do not mix new and old batteries. Do not mix alkaline batteries, standard (carbon-zinc) batteries, or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- If battery leakage is found, stop using the product immediately and disconnect the power supply.
- Put the leaking battery into a sealed bag or leak-proof container, mark it as "Leaking Battery" and send it to a collection point for disposal.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Precautions

- Before cleaning this product, you must turn off the power and unplug it.
- After cleaning, allow the unit to dry completely before turning on or storing.
- If the fan will not be used for an extended period, unplug the power plug. We recommend storing it in its original packaging in a dry place.
- Do not wash the body directly with water. Use a soft cloth lightly dampened with a small amount of neutral detergent to gently wipe the surface, then wipe dry. Do not use any abrasive cleaners or solvents, such as gasoline.
- Do not disassemble the appliance for modification. Regularly inspect and clean the appliance to extend its service life.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If the fan exhibits an abnormal condition during use, please check the following items before requesting repair.

Troubleshooting	Check the following
Fan blades do not rotate.	• Are the fan blades installed correctly? • Is the power plug inserted into the outlet? • Are the fan blades touching the guard?
The fan blades rotate but emit an unusual noise.	• Is the screw-on hub cap correctly securing the fan blade in place? • Are the front and rear grilles installed correctly? • Are the fan blades touching the grille?
	• Are the fan blades and grille clean?
Cannot operate with the remote control.	• See "REMOTE CONTROL BATTERY INSTALLATION/REMOTE CONTROL BUTTON DESCRIPTION" — P05/P06/P08/P09 • Are the batteries depleted? • Is the battery installation direction (the + direction) correct? • Is the child lock set?
