# 控制面板



1 電源	按此鍵以開啟或關閉您的洗碗機。
2 程序	請按「<」或「>」鍵選擇合適的洗碗程序，相應程序指示燈將會亮起。

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






## 清洗程序

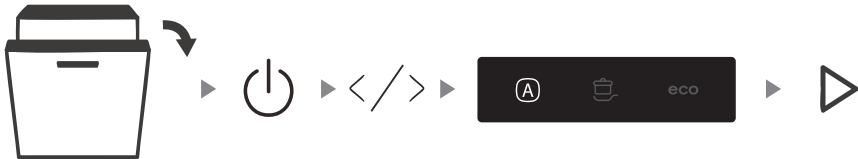

## 節能

1. 預先沖洗餐具會導致水資源及能源消耗增加，並不建議採用此做法。
2. 若按照說明書指示使用家用洗碗機清洗餐具，其運作時所消耗的能源及用水量通常較手洗更為節省。

## 啟動

1. 請先將插頭插入插座。電源應採用220-240V交流電50Hz規格，並配備10A 220-240V交流電插座。
2. 確保供水系統已完全開啟至全壓狀態。
3. 按下「電源」按鈕啟動洗碗機。
4. 按「<」同「>」揀選程序；選定程序後，程序指示燈會亮起。
5. 按下「開始/取消」按鈕後關門，洗碗機將開始運作。



## 更改程序

若程序僅運作短暫時間方可更改，否則洗滌劑可能已釋出或含洗滌劑之洗滌水已排走。若出現此情況，需重新啟動洗碗機並補充洗滌劑分配器。要重置洗碗機，請按照以下指示操作：

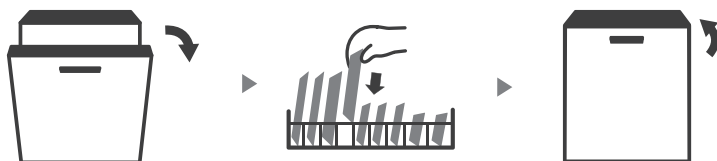
1. 稍微打開門以停止洗碗機運作，待噴臂停止轉動後，便可完全開啟機門。
2. 長按啟動/取消按鈕超過3秒，洗碗機將進入待機模式。
3. 您可以將程序切換至所需嘅循環模式設定。
4. 按下啟動/取消按鈕後關上門，洗碗機便會開始運作



## 添加餐具

在洗碗機程序啟動前，可隨時添加額外餐具。若需在清洗過程中重新添加餐具，請按照以下指示操作：

1. 稍微打開門以停止洗碗程序。
2. 噴臂停止運作後，您可以完全打開門。
3. 請放入額外餐具。
4. 關上門。當門關閉後，運作將恢復，將於10秒延遲後開始工作。



## 清洗程序結束

程序完成後，機器會發出8秒蜂鳴聲，隨後顯示「結束」。

- 關閉機器

按下電源按鈕關閉洗碗機。

- 小心開啟門

餐具在高溫狀態下更容易受損。餐具應冷卻約15分鐘，然後從洗碗機中取出。

- 清潔洗碗機

洗碗機內部仍殘留水滴屬正常現象。

# 使用洗碗機

由於洗碗機生產線進行水質檢測，出貨時可能有少量殘留水份，此屬正常情況。

## 軟水器

必須手動使用水硬度調節盤來設定軟水器。

此軟水器專為去除水中礦物質及鹽分而設計，該等物質會對電器運作產生損害或不良影響。

礦物質含量越高，水質硬度就越高。

請根據您所在地區嘅水質硬度調校軟水器。您所在地區的自來水公司可提供有關當地水質硬度的專業建議。

### 調節鹽分消耗量

If the “  ” indicator is lit, it means the dishwasher is low on dishwasher salt and requires a refill.  The “H” indicator is lit, it means the hours when Dry Storage is selected.

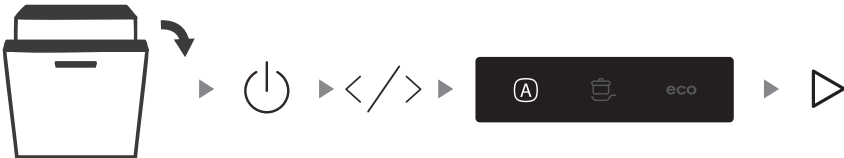

## Saving energy

1. Pre-rinsing of tableware items leads to increased water and energy consumption and is not recommended.
2. Washing tableware in a household dishwasher usually consumes less energy and water in the use phase than hand dishwashing when the household dishwasher is used according to the instructions.

## Start up

1. The plug shall be firstly plugged into the socket. Power supply shall be of 220-240V AC 50Hz type, with socket of 10 A 220-240V AC.
2. Make sure that the water supply is turned on to full pressure.
3. press "Power" button turn on the dishwasher.
4. Press "<" and ">" to select the program; after selecting the program, the program indicator lights up.
5. Close the door after press the Start/Cancel button, the dishwasher will start its cycle.



## Changing the program mid-cycle

A program can only be changed if it has been running only for a short period of time, otherwise the detergent may have already been released or the the wash water with detergent has already been drained. If this is the case, the dishwasher needs to be reset and the detergent dispenser must be refilled. To reset the dishwasher, follow the instructions below:

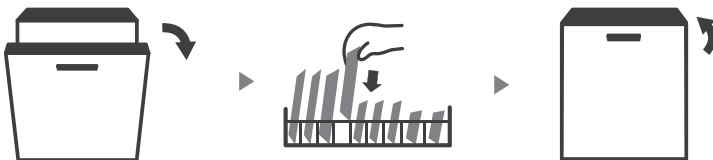
1. Open the door a little to stop the dishwasher, after the spray arm stop working, you can open the door completely.
2. Press the Start/Cancel button more than 3 seconds, the dishwasher will enter standby mode.
3. You can change the program to the desired cycle setting.
4. Close the door after press the Start/Cancel button, the dishwasher will start



## Put additional dishes in

Additional dishes can be placed in at any time before dishwasher program start. If you want to reload dishes in the process of washing, please follow instructions below:

1. Open the door a little to stop the washing.
2. After the spray arms stopped working, you can open the door completely.
3. Put the additional dishes in.
4. Close the door. When the door is closed, the operation will resume, and the load will start to work after a 10 seconds delay.



## End of washing program

---

After the program finishes, the machine show "End" after the buzzer beeps for 8 seconds.

- Turn off the machine

Press power button to turn off the dish washer.

- Open the door carefully

Hot dishes are more likely to be damaged. The dishes shall be cool for about 15 minutes and then taken out from the dishwasher.

- Clear the dishwasher

It is normal that the dishwasher still remains wet inside.



### **WARNING**

It is extremely emely dangerous to open the door in the process of washing as this may cause severe burn by hot water.

# Use the dishwasher

Due to the water inspection of the dishwasher production line, there may be some residual water during shipment, which is a normal situation.

## Water softener

The water softener must be set manually, using the water hardness dial.

The water softener is designed to remove minerals and salts from the water, which would have a detrimental or adverse effect on the operation of the appliance.

The more minerals there are, the harder your water is.

The softener should be adjusted according to the hardness of the water in your area. Your local Water Authority can advise you on the hardness of the water in your area.

### Adjusting salt consumption

The dishwasher is designed to allow for adjustment in the amount of salt consumed based on the hardness of the water used. This is intended to optimise and customise the level of salt consumption.

Please follow the steps below for adjustment in salt consumption.

1. Open the door, switch on the appliance;
2. Within 60 seconds after the appliance was switched on press the '>' button for more than 5 seconds to enter the water softener setting mode.
3. Press the '>' button again to select the proper setting according to your local water hardness, the setting will change in the following sequence:  
H3->H4->H5->H6->H1->H2->H3;
4. Without operation in 5 seconds or press the Power button to complete the setup and exit the setup mode.

## Adding salt to the softener

### WARNING

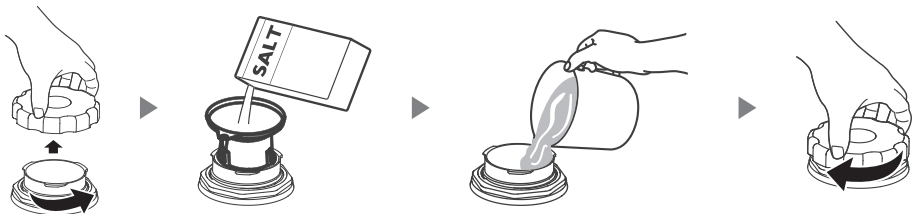
- **Only use salt specifically designed for dishwashers use!**

Every other type of salt not specifically designed for dishwasher use, especially table salt, will damage the water softener. In case of damages caused by the use of unsuitable salt the manufacturer does not give any warranty nor is liable for any damages caused.

- **Only fill with salt before running a cycle.**

This will prevent any grains of salt or salty water, which may have been spilled, remaining on the bottom of the machine for any period of time, which may cause corrosion.

Please follow the steps below for adding dishwasher salt:



1. Remove the lower basket and unscrew the reservoir cap.
2. Place the end of the funnel (if supplied) into the hole and pour in about 1.5kg of dishwasher salt.
3. Fill the salt container to its maximum limit with water, it is normal for a small amount of water to come out of the salt container.
4. After filling the container, screw back the cap tightly.
5. The salt warning light will turn off after the salt container has been filled with salt.
6. Immediately after filling the salt into the salt container, a washing program should be started (We suggest to use a short program). Otherwise the filter system, pump or other important parts of the machine may be damaged by salty water. This is out of warranty.

### Attention

- The salt container must only be refilled when the salt warning light (⚡) in the control panel comes on. Depending on how well the salt dissolves, the salt warning light may still be on even though the salt container is filled. If there is no salt warning light in the control panel (for some Models), you can estimate when to fill the salt into the softener by the cycles that the dishwasher has run.
- If salt has spilled, run a soak or quick program to remove it.

## Function of the rinse aid and detergent


The rinse aid is released during the final rinse to prevent water from forming droplets on your dishes, which can leave spots and streaks. It also improves drying by allowing water to roll off the dishes. Your dishwasher is designed to use liquid rinse aids.

### **Warning**

Never fill the rinse aid dispenser with any other substances (e.g. Dishwasher cleaning agent, liquid detergent). This would damage the appliance.

### **When to refill the rinse aid**

The regularity of the dispenser needing to be refilled depends on how often dishes are washed and the rinse aid setting used.

- The Low Rinse Aid indicator () will appear in the display when more rinse aid is needed.
- Do not overfill the rinse aid dispenser.

### **Function of detergent**

The chemical ingredients that compose the detergent are necessary to remove, crush and dispense all dirt out of the dishwasher. Most of the commercial quality detergents are suitable for this purpose.

### **Warning**

#### ● Proper Use of Detergent

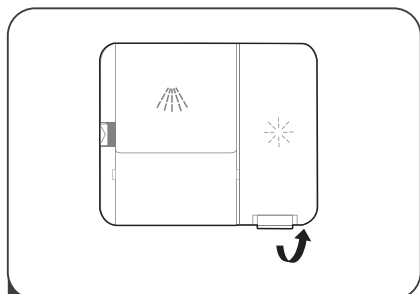
Use only detergent specifically made for dishwashers use. Keep your detergent fresh and dry.

Do not fill detergent into the dispenser until you are ready to start the dishwasher.

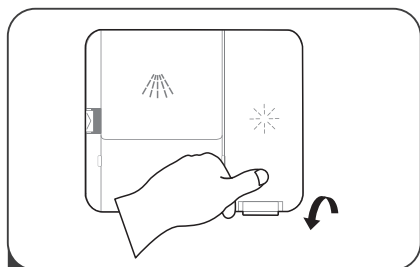

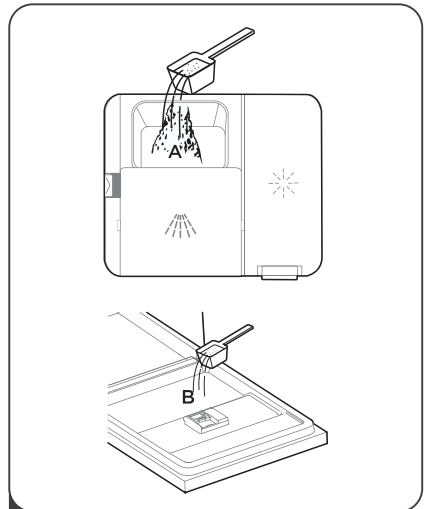
To achieve a better drying performance with limited rinse aid, the dishwasher is designed to adjust the consumption by user. Follow the below steps.

1. Open the door and switch on the appliance.
2. Within 60 seconds after step 1, press the program '>' button more than 5 seconds, and then press the Delay button to enter the set model, the rinse aid indication blinks as 1 Hz frequency.
3. Press the program '>' button to select the proper set according to your using habits, the sets will change in the following sequence: d3->d4->d5->d1->d2->d3.  
The higher the number, the more rinse aid the dishwasher uses. The factory setting is: d3.
4. Without operation in 5 seconds or press the Power button to exit the set model, the set success.

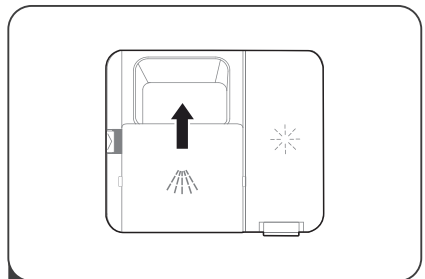
## Adding detergent to the dispenser



- 1** Please choose an open way according to the actual situation.
1. Open the cap by sliding the release catch.
  2. Open the cap by pressing down the release catch.
  3. Open the cap by pressing in the release latch.



- 2** Add detergent into the larger cavity (A) for the main wash cycle. For better cleaning result, especially if you have very dirt items, pour a small amount of detergent onto the door. The additional detergent will activate during the pre-wash phase.



- 3** Close the flap by sliding it to the front and then pressing it down.

### **NOTE:**

- Be aware that depending on the soiling of water, setting may be different.
- Please observe the manufacturer's recommendations on the detergent packaging.

# Install dishwasher bowl basket

## Suggestion

- Purchase dishes suitable for dishwasher.
- Use a suitable mild dishwashing powder. If necessary, consult the manufacturer for more information.
- For special appliances, try to select a washing program that with a lower temperature.
- Do not take out the glass dishes immediately after the program ends to prevent damage.

## Use the dishwashing machine rationally

### Not for:

- Wooden, ivory, porcelain or pearl shank tool
- Non heat-resistant plastic products
- Stale non heat-resistant cutters with glue adhesive part
- Cohesive knives or dishes
- Tin or copper vessels
- Crystal glass
- Rusty steel products
- Wooden utensils
- Synthetic fiber products

### Limited use:

- After several cleanings, some glassware will become dull
- Silver or aluminum products tend to change color during cleaning
- Color of smooth dishes may fade out if often washed

## Precautions before and after the bowl basket is placed

(For the best use of dishwasher, follow the instructions below. For different models, the characteristics and appearance of the basket will be different) Clear larger food residues. Soften the residue of burnt food left on the pan. It is not necessary to rinse dishes with water first. Place the dishes in the dishwasher as follows:

- Cups, glasses, pots and so on are placed face down.
- For curved or concave and convex vessels, place them diagonally so that the water flows out.
- All utensils should be placed safely and must not be overturned.
- All utensils should be placed that the arms can rotate freely during washing.

### Attention

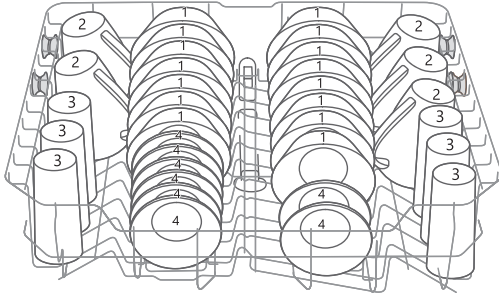
For small objects, it is easy to fall out from the basket, which should not be placed in the dishwasher.

- The open of hollow tablewares (such as cups, glasses, pots, etc.) should face downward so that water does not easily remain in the container or grooves.
- Dishes and knives should not be placed in other utensils, and they can't overlaid each other.
- Do not place glass close to each other to avoid damage.
- For long knives, placing upright is very dangerous.
- Long or sharp knives (eg. meat cleavers) should be placed horizontally in the basket.
- Do not use the dishwasher overloaded so that you can get better cleaning performance.

## Loading the upper basket

Use the upper rack for small or delicate items such as small plates, cups, saucers, glasses, and dishwasher-safe plastic items.

- Place items so that the open end faces down for cleaning and drying.
- Do not stack items on top of each other.

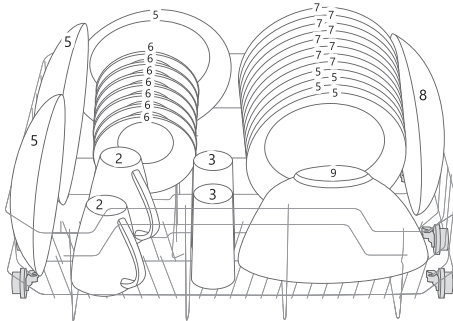

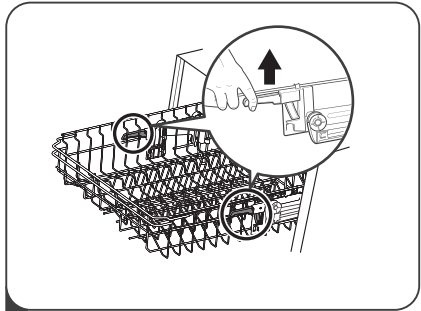
## Adjusting the upper basket

The height of the upper basket can be easily adjusted to accommodate taller dishes in either the upper or lower basket. We recommend adjust the height of the upper basket before loading dishes.

To adjust the height of the upper rack, follow these steps:



**1** To raise the upper basket, just lift the upper basket at the center of each side until the basket locks into place in the upper position. It is not necessary to lift the adjuster handle.

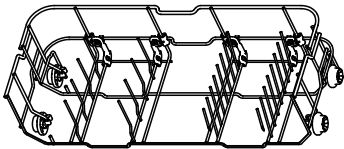

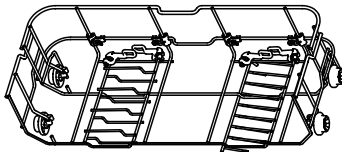

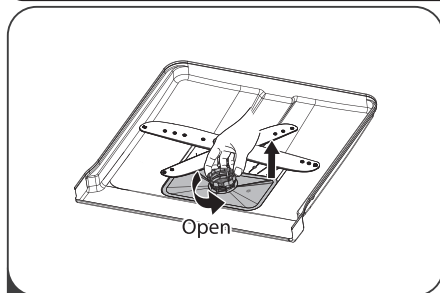
# Cleaning and care

## Filter cleaning

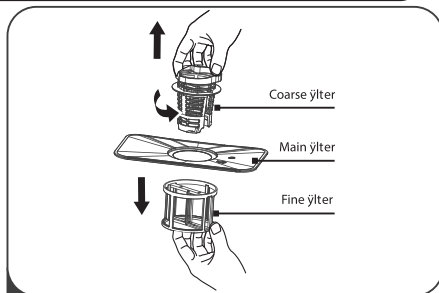
The filtering system in the base of the wash cabinet retains coarse debris from the washing cycle, including foreign objects such as tooth picks or shards. The collected coarse debris may cause the filters to clog. Check the condition of the filters regularly, carefully remove foreign objects and clean the parts of the filtering system if necessary with water. Follow the steps below to clean the filter.

### WARNING

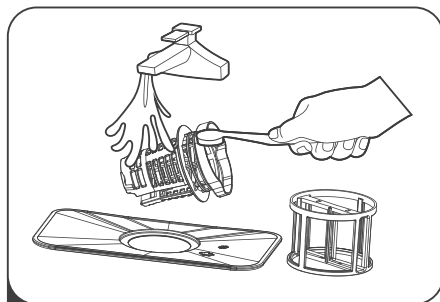
- Do not over tighten the filters. Put the filters back in sequence securely, otherwise coarse debris could get into the system and cause a blockage.
- Never use the dishwasher without filters in place. Improper replacement of the filter may reduce the performance level of the appliance and damage dishes and utensils.



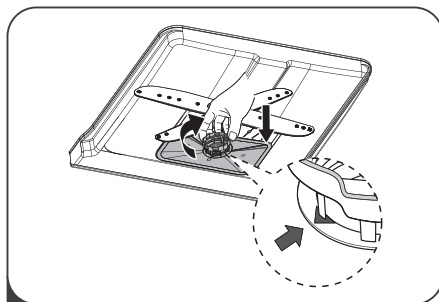
- 1 Hold the coarse filter and rotate it anticlockwise to unlock the filter. Lift the filter upwards and out of the dishwasher.



- 2 The fine filter can be pulled off the bottom of the filter assembly. The coarse filter can be detached from the main filter by gently squeezing the tabs at the top and pulling it away.



- 3 Larger food remnants can be cleaned by rinsing the filter under running water. For a more thorough clean, use a soft cleaning brush.

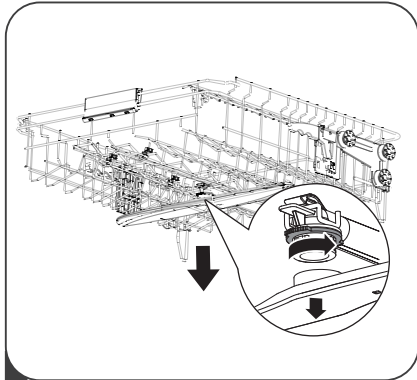


- 4 Reassemble the filters in the reverse order of the disassembly, replace the filter insert, and rotate clockwise to the close arrow.

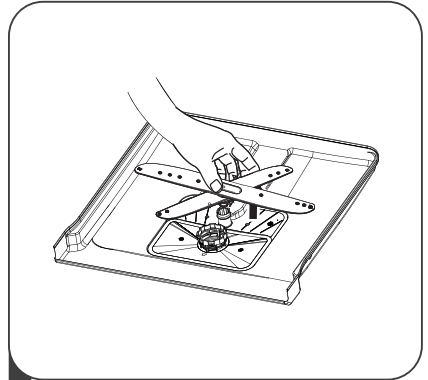
## Spray arms cleaning

It is necessary to clean the spray arms regularly for hard water chemicals will clog the spray arm jets and bearings.

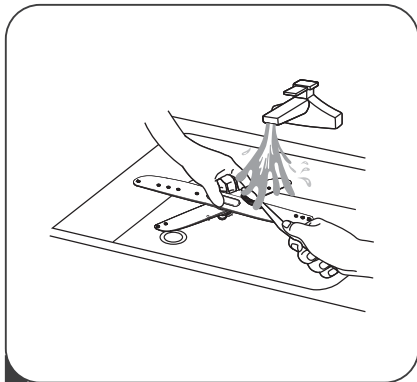
To clean the spray arms, follow the instructions below:



- 1** To remove the upper spray arm, hold the nut in the center still and rotate the spray arm counterclockwise to remove it.



- 2** To remove the lower spray arm, pull out the spray arm upward.



- 3** Wash the arms in soapy and warm water and use a soft brush to clean the jets. Replace them after rinsing them thoroughly.

# Care and maintenance

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## **The door and the door seal**

Clean the door seals regularly with a soft damp cloth to remove food deposits. When the dishwasher is being loaded, food and drink residues may drip onto the sides of the dishwasher door. These surfaces are outside the wash cabinet and are not accessed by water from the spray arms. Any deposits should be wiped off before the door is closed.

## **The control panel**

Control panel can be wiped with a slightly wet cloth. After cleaning, make sure it is completely dry. Do not use Sharp tools, Scratch sponge, or Rough detergent anywhere in the machine.

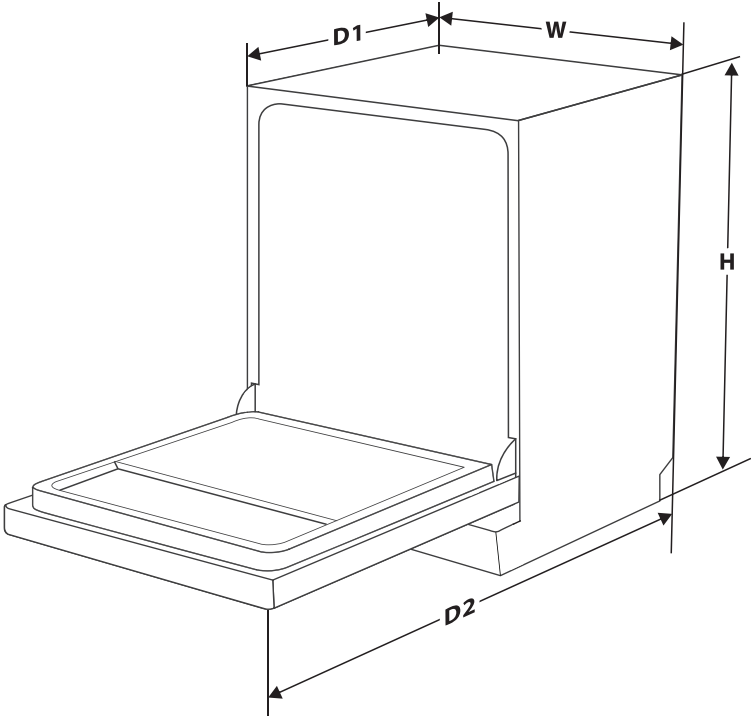

- Do not use spray detergent to clean the door, as it may damage the door lock and other electrical components.

## Power requirements

Please check the label of rated value of power supply system for knowing rated voltage and connect the machine to appropriate power supply. 10A fuse is required and time-delay fuse or circuit breaker is recommended. Only separate circuit is suitable for this machine.

## Machine connection

Make sure that supplied voltage and frequency correspond to those on rating plate. Plug can only be connected to a properly grounded socket. If the socket that the machine must be connected to is not suitable for the plug, replace the socket, and do not use a power adapter that may cause overheating and burning.

## Water connection

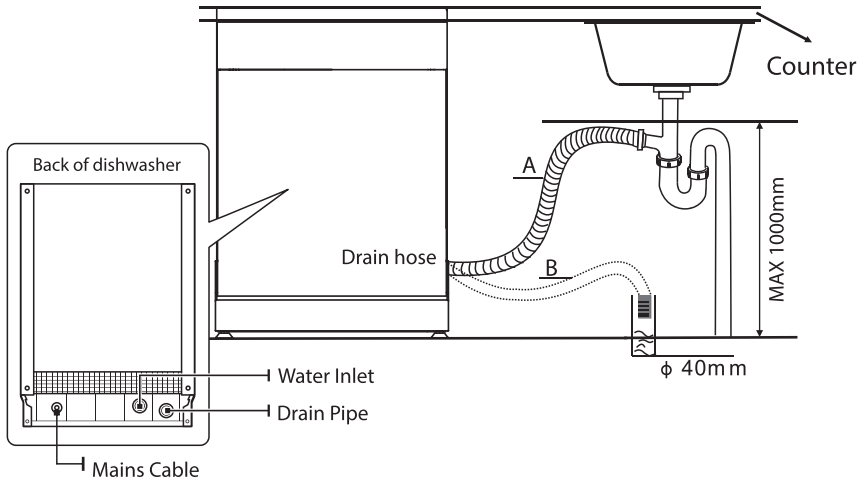
Connect the cold water supply hose to a threaded 1/2(inch) connector and make sure that it is fastened tightly in place.

If the water pipes are new or have not been used for an extended period of time, let the water run to make sure that the water is clear. This precaution is needed to avoid the risk of the water inlet to be blocked and damage the appliance.

## Connection of drain hoses

Insert the drain hose into a drain pipe with a minimum diameter of 4 cm, or let it run into the sink, making sure to avoid bending or crimping it. The height of drain pipe must be less than 1000mm. The free end of the hose must not be immersed in water to avoid the back flow of it.

⚠ Please securely fix the drain hose in either position A or position B



### How to drain excess water from hoses

If the sink is 1000 higher from the floor, the excess water in hoses cannot be drained directly into the sink. It will be necessary to drain excess water from hoses into a bowl or suitable container that is held outside and lower than the sink.

### Water outlet

Connect the water drain hose. The drain hose must be correctly fitted to avoid water leaks. Ensure that the water drain hose is not kinked or squashed.

### Extension hose

If you need a drain hose extension, make sure to use a similar drain hose. It must be no longer than 4 meters; otherwise the cleaning effect of the dishwasher could be reduced.

### Syphon connection

The waste connection must be at a height less than 100 cm (maximum) from the bottom of the dish. The water drain hose should be fixed.

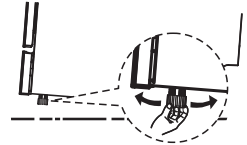
## Positioning The Appliance

Position the appliance in the desired location. The back should rest against the wall behind it, and the sides, along the adjacent cabinets or walls. The dishwasher is equipped with water supply and drain hoses that can be positioned either to the right or the left sides to facilitate proper installation.

### Levelling the appliance

Once the appliance is positioned for levelling, the height of the dishwasher may be altered via adjustment of the screwing level of the feet.

In any case, the appliance should not be inclined more than 2°

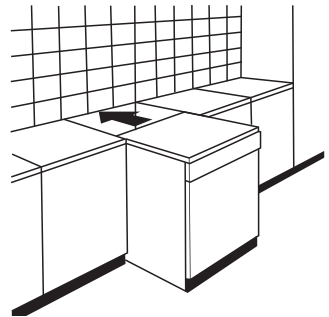


## Free Standing Installation

### Type 1: Fitting between existing cabinets

The height of the dishwasher, 845 mm, has been designed in order to allow the machine to be fitted between existing cabinets of the same height in modern fitted kitchens. The feet can be adjusted so that correct height is reached.

The laminated top of the machine does not require any particular care since it is heatproof, scratch proof and stain proof.

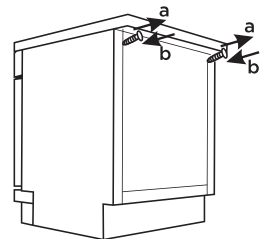


### Type 2: Underneath existing work top

(When fitting beneath a work top)

In most modern fitted kitchens there is only one single work top under which cabinets and electrical appliances are fitted.

In this case remove the work top of the dishwasher by unscrewing the screws under the rear edge of the top (a).



### ⚠ Attention

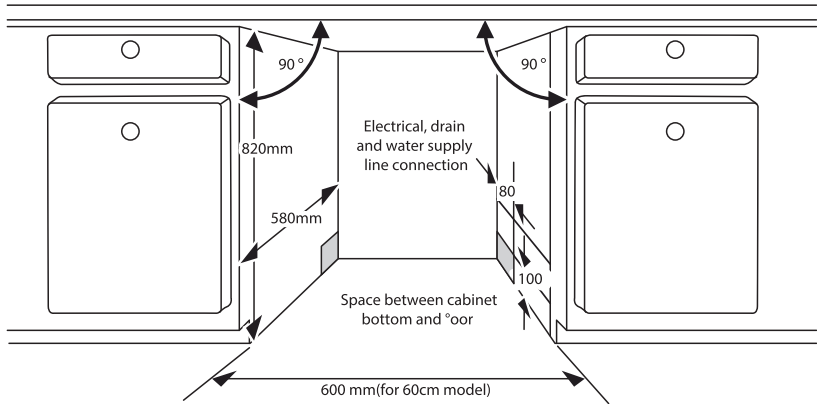
After removing the work top, the screws must be screwed again under the rear edge of the top (b).

## Selecting the best location for the dishwasher


The installation position of the dishwasher should be near the existing inlet and drain hose and power socket.

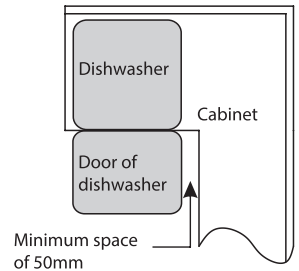
Illustrations of cabinet dimensions and installation position of the dishwasher.

1. Less than 5 mm between the top of dishwasher and cabinet and the outer door aligned to cabinet.



2. If dishwasher is installed at the corner of the cabinet, there should be some space when the door is opened.

 Depending on where your electrical outlet is, you may need to cut a hole in the opposite cabinet side.



# Troubleshooting

## Before connecting customer service center

Please check the chart below before connecting customer service center

Foam remains in liner	Improper dishwashing powder is used.	In order to avoid foaming, only dishwashing powder specially designed for dishwasher can be used. In such case, open the door and allow the foam to evaporate. In case of too much foam, start any washing program for cleaning.
	Detergent overflows.	Wipe off spilled cleaner immediately.
Colors on liner	Use dishwashing powder with coloring agent.	Make sure that dishwashing powder used is free of coloring agent.
White film on liner	Hard water minerals.	Use wet sponge with dishwashing powder and wear rubber gloves for interior cleaning. Do not use any detergent other than dishwashing powder as it may generate foam or bubble.

## Error code

If there is a malfunction the dishwasher will display an error code. The following table shows possible error codes and their causes.

Error code	Code name	Possible cause
E1	Long water intake time	Flow-meters, drain valves, or pump failures shall be repaired by qualified serviceman.
E3	Abnormal heating	Heating pipe or thermistor is at abnormal state, which needs to be unplugged the power plug from the outlet, and needs to be repaired by qualified serviceman.
E4	Overflow or water tank problem	The machine occur overflow or something wrong with the floater in the water tank, needs to be repaired by qualified serviceman.
E8	Failure of orientation of distributary valve.	Open circuit or break of distributary valve.

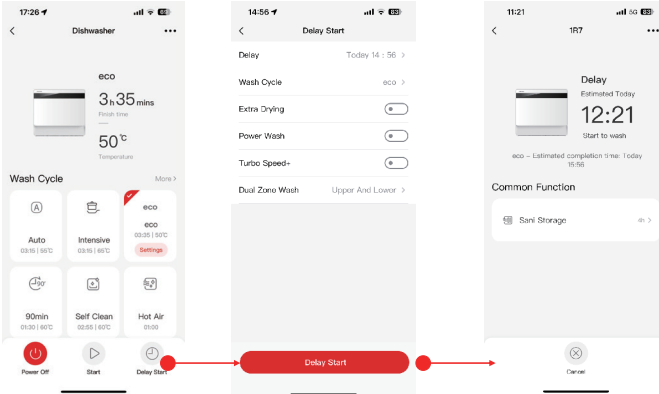
- 2 Click directly on the desired washing cycle or click “more” for additional washing cycle to choose. After selecting a washing cycle, click “start” to begin the operation.
