

微波爐零件和配件名稱

將微波爐和所有材料從紙箱和爐腔中取出。

微波爐配有以下配件:

轉盤安裝



- a. 切勿將玻璃托盤倒置。根據圖示把玻璃托盤依正確方向放在轉盤環上,玻璃托盤應可順暢地轉動。
- b 烹調時必須使用玻璃托盤和轉盤環組件。
- c. 所有食物和食物容器必須放在玻璃托盤上 進行烹調。
- d. 如果玻璃托盤或轉盤環組件出現裂縫或斷 裂,請聯繫您就近的授權服務中心。

檯面安裝


取出所有包裝材料和配件。檢查微波爐是否有任何損壞,如凹痕或爐門破損。如果微波爐損壞,請勿安裝。

機身外殼: 拆下微波爐機身外殼表面的任何保護膜。

不要取下貼在微波爐爐腔的淺棕色雲母片,這是用以保護磁控管。

安裝

1. 選擇一個為進氣口和/或出風口提供足夠開放空間的水平面。



- (1) 最小安裝高度為85厘米。
- (2) 產品應放置於貼近牆壁位置。 在微波爐上方留出最少30厘米的距離,微波爐和任何相鄰牆壁之間需要距離最少20厘米。
- (3) 請勿從微波爐底部取下爐腳。
- (4) 阻塞進氣口和/或出口可能會損壞微波爐。
- (5) 將微波爐盡可能遠離收音機和電視機。微波爐的操作可能會對您的收音機或電視接收造成干擾。
- 2. 將微波爐插入標準家庭插座。確保電壓和頻率與額定值標籤上的電壓和頻率相同。

操作

1. 時鐘設定

微波爐通電後, 螢幕顯示 "0:00", 蜂鳴器鳴響一次。

- 1) 按下"計時器/時鐘"兩次選擇時鐘功能,小時數位將閃爍。
- 2) 轉動 "》"調節小時數位,輸入時間應在0-23之間。
- 3) 按下 "**開始/+30秒**", 分鐘數字將閃爍。
- 4) 轉動 " " 調節分鐘數字, 輸入時間應在0-59之間。
- 5) 按下"開始/+30秒"完成時鐘設定。":"將閃爍,時間亮起。
- 6) 如果需要重置時鐘,請重複步驟1至步驟5。
- 注: 1) 若不設定時鐘,則通電時時鐘不工作。
 - 2) 在時鐘設定過程中,若您按下"**停止/取消**"鍵,或者在1分鐘内無操作,微波爐會自動回到之前的狀態。

2. 微波烹調

按一下"微波"鍵, 螢幕顯示 "800w", "00:00" 亮起。多次按下"微波"或轉動 " " 選擇所需功率,每按一次依次顯示 "800w"、"600w"、"400w"、"200w"、"100w"。 再按下 "開始/+30秒"確認,轉動 " " 設置烹調時間,範圍為從0:05到95:00。按下 "開始/+30秒"開始烹調。

例子:使用600W微波功率烹調20分鐘,您可以按照以下步驟操作微波爐。

- 1) 按一次"微波", 螢幕將顯示 "800w"。
- 2) 再按一次"微波"或轉動 " 選擇混合600W的烹調功率。
- 3) 按下 "**開始/+30秒**" 確認, 螢幕將顯示 "600w"。
- 4) 轉動 " 調整烹調時間,直到螢幕顯示 "20:00" 為止
- 5) 按下 "開始/+30秒" 開始烹調。

3. 燒烤或混合烹調

在待機狀態下,按一下"燒烤/混合",螢幕將顯示"G"。多次按下"燒烤/混合"或轉動"災"選擇所需功率,每按一次依次顯示"G"、"C1"、"C2"。再按下"開始/+30秒"確認,轉動"災"設置烹調時間,範圍為從0:05到95:00。按下"開始/+30秒"開始烹調。

例子:使用55%微波功率和45%的燒烤功率(C1)烹調10分鐘,您可以按照以下步驟操作微波爐。

- 1) 按一下"**燒烤/混合**",螢幕將顯示"G"。
- 2) 多次按下 "**燒烤/混合**" 或轉動 " " 選擇混合1(C1)模式。
- 3) 按下 "**開始/+30秒**" 確認, 螢幕將顯示 "C1"。
- 4) 轉動 " " 調整烹調時間,直到螢幕顯示 "10:00" 為止。
- 5) 按下 "開始/+30秒" 開始烹調。

4. 快速啟動 (建議加熱器皿及配件:微波安全器皿加蓋或保鮮膜覆蓋)

- 1) 在多段火力烹調過程中,每按一次"**開始/+30秒**"可增加30秒的烹調時間。解凍階段無法增加時間。
- 2) 在微波、燒烤、混合烹調或按時間解凍狀態中,每按一次"**開始/+30秒**"可增加30秒的烹調時間。
- 3) 在待機狀態中,向左轉動 " ② " 設置烹調時間,100%微波功率 "800w" 亮起, "00:00" 閃爍。然後向左或向右轉動 " ② " 設置烹調時間(或按下 "**開始/+30秒**" 設置30秒烹調時間,微波爐自動開始烹調)。選擇烹調時間後,按下 "**開始/+30秒**" 開始烹調。

5. 按時解凍 (建議加熱器皿及配件:微波安全器皿)

- 1) 按一下"解凍"鍵,微波爐顯示解凍功率 "240w", "00:00" 閃爍提醒您輸入解凍時間。
- 2) 轉動 " 》 "選擇解凍時間。最長時間為95分鐘。
- 3) 按下"開始/+30秒"開始解凍。解凍功率無法改變。

6. 按重解凍 (建議加熱器皿及配件:微波安全器皿)

- 1) 按兩次 "**解凍**" 鍵, "100" 閃爍, 提醒您輸入解凍重量。
- 2) 轉動 " ()" 選擇食物重量, 範圍為100g至1500g。 (每100g為每次轉動單位)
- 3) 按下"開始/+30秒" 開始解凍。

7. 計時器

- 1) 按一下"計時器/時鐘", 螢幕將顯示00:00。
- 3) 按下"開始/+30秒"確認。
- 4) 廚房計時器時間到,蜂鳴器鳴響5次,螢幕將顯示 "End"。
- 注: 1) 計時器適用於微波爐以外的其他煮食方法的時間倒數。例如用作明火蒸魚的計時器。
 - 2) 計時器工作時無法查詢當前時間。
 - 3) 在計時器工作期間,按下"停止/取消"可停止計時器,微波爐回到待機狀態。

8. 自動功能表

向右轉動 " ② " 選擇功能表,將顯示 "A-1" 至 "A-12"。

按下"開始/+30秒"確認。

轉動""選擇功能表中的預設重量。

4) 按下 "開始/+30秒" 開始烹調。

9. 多段火力烹調 (建議加熱器皿及配件: 微波安全器皿)

至多可設置2個烹調火力。在多段火力烹調中,若其中一個階段為解凍階段,則該階段自動成為第一個階段。

注: 計時器和自動功能表無法在多段火力烹調功能下工作。快速啟動可設置為多段火力烹調中的一個。

示例: 若您想解凍食物5分鐘, 然後用600w的微波功率加熱7分鐘, 操作如下:

- 1) 按一次 "**解凍**" 鍵, 微波爐顯示 "240w", "00:00" 閃爍。
- 2) 轉動 " 罗選擇解凍時間,直到螢幕顯示 "5:00" 為止。
- 3) 按一下"微波", 螢幕顯示 "800w"。
- 4) 再按一次"微波"或轉動 "¹)"選擇600w的烹調功率。
- 5) 按下 "**開始/+30秒**" 確認, 螢幕將顯示 "600w"。
- 6) 轉動 " " 調整烹調時間,直到螢幕顯示 "7:00" 為止。
- 7) 按下"**開始/+30秒**"開始烹調,第一階段蜂鳴器鳴響一次,解凍時間開始倒數。蜂鳴器 再次鳴響,進入第二階段烹調。烹調完成後,蜂鳴器鳴響五次。

10. 查詢功能

在烹調狀態下,按下"時鐘"查詢時間,時間顯示3秒。

11. 兒童鎖功能 🗝

鎖定:在待機狀態下,按 "**停止/取消**"鍵3秒,長鳴 "嗶"聲表示進入兒童鎖狀態。鎖定指示燈^{••}◎亮,如已設置,則當前時間將顯示。

退出鎖定:在鎖定狀態下,按 "停止/取消" 鍵3秒,長鳴 "嗶" 聲表示退出兒童鎖狀態。

12. 轉盤重置功能

烹調完成後,若轉盤不在開始位置,則將進入轉盤復位功能。此時,照明燈、風扇和轉盤都在工作 "【ここ】" 將動態顯示。轉盤復位後,微波爐停止烹調,提醒烹調完畢。

注:

- 1. 此功能只適用於一次性完成的烹調。若在烹調過程中暫停或打開爐門,則此次烹調無法進入轉盤復位功能。
- 2. 在重定模式下,開門或按下"停止/取消"按鈕,微波爐將回到待機狀態。

- 1. Read and follow the specific: "PRECAUTIONS TO AVOID POSSIBLE EXPOSURE TO EXCESSIVE MICROWAVE ENERGY".
- 2. This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- 3. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- 4. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- 5. WARNING: Ensure that the appliance is switched off before replacing the lamp to avoid the possibility of electric shock.
- 6. The microwave oven is intended for heating food and beverages. Drying of food or clothing and heating of warming pads, slippers, sponges, damp cloth and similar may lead to risk of injury, ignition or fire.

- 7. WARNING: It is hazardous for anyone other than a competent person to carry out any service or repair operation that involves the removal of a cover which gives protection against exposure to microwave energy.
- 8. WARNING: Liquids and other foods must not be heated in sealed containers since they are liable to explode.
- 9. When heating food in plastic or paper containers, keep an eye on the oven due to the possibility of ignition.
- Only use utensils that are suitable for use in microwave ovens.
- 11. If smoke is emitted, switch off or unplug the appliance and keep the door closed in order to stifle any flames.
- 12. Microwave heating of beverages can result in delayed eruptive boiling, therefore care must be taken when handling the container.
- 13. The contents of feeding bottles and baby food jars shall be stirred or shaken and the temperature checked before consumption, in order to avoid burns.
- 14. The oven should be cleaned regularly and any food deposits removed.
- 15. Failure to maintain the oven in a clean condition could lead to deterioration of the surface that could adversely affect the life of the appliance and possibly result in a hazardous situation.
- 16. Only use the temperature probe recommended for this oven. (for ovens provided with a facility to use a temperature-sensing probe.)

- 17. The microwave oven must be operated with the decorative door open. (for ovens with a decorative door.)
- 18. This appliance is intended to be used in household and similar applications such as:
- -staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments;
- -by clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments;
- -farm houses;
- -bed and breakfast type environments.
- 19. The appliance is intended to be used freestanding.
- 20. The rear surface of appliances shall be placed against a wall.
- 21. The temperature of accessible surfaces may be high when the appliance is operating.
- 22. WARNING: When the appliance is operated in the combination mode, children should only use the oven under adult supervision due to the temperatures generated.
- 23. Eggs in their shell and whole hard-boiled eggs should not be heated in microwave ovens since they may explode, even after microwave heating has ended.
- 24. The appliance must not be installed behind a decorative door in order to avoid overheating.
- (This is not applicable for appliances with decorative door.)
- 25. The microwave oven shall not be placed in a cabinet unless it has been tested in a cabinet.

- 26. Metallic containers for food and beverages are not allowed during microwave cooking.
- 27. The appliance shall not be cleaned with a steam cleaner.
- 28. The appliances are not intended to be operated by means of an external timer or separate remote-control system.

- 3. The door frame and seal and neighboring parts must be cleaned carefully with a damp cloth when they are dirty.
- 4. Do not use harsh abrasive cleaners or sharp metal scrapers to clean the oven door glass since they can scratch the surface, which may result in shattering of the glass.
- 5. Cleaning Tip---For easier cleaning of the cavity walls that the food cooked can touch: Place half a lemon in a bowl, add 300ml (1/2 pint) water and heat on 100% microwave power for 10 minutes. Wipe the oven clean using a soft, dry cloth.

See the instructions on "Materials you can use in microwave oven or to be avoided in microwave oven." There may be certain non-metallic utensils that are not safe to use for microwaving. If in doubt, you can test the utensil in question following the procedure below.

Utensil Test:

- 1. Fill a microwave-safe container with 1 cup of cold water (250ml) along with the utensil in question.
- 2. Cook on maximum power for 1 minute.
- 3. Carefully feel the utensil. If the empty utensil is warm, do not use it for microwave cooking.
- 4. Do not exceed 1 minute cooking time.

Browning dish	Follow manufacturer's instructions. The bottom of browning dish must be at least 3/16 inch (5mm) above the turntable. Incorrect usage may cause the turntable to break.
Dinnerware	Microwave-safe only. Follow manufacturer's instructions. Do not use cracked or chipped dishes.
Glass jars	Always remove lid. Use only to heat food until just warm. Most glass jars are not heat resistant and may break.
Glassware	Heat-resistant oven glassware only. Make sure there is no metallic trim. Do not use cracked or chipped dishes.
Oven cooking bags	Follow manufacturer's instructions. Do not close with metal tie. Make slits to allow steam to escape.
Paper plates and cups	Use for short–term cooking/warming only. Do not leave oven unattended while cooking.
Paper towels	Use to cover food for reheating and absorbing fat. Use with supervision for a short-term cooking only.
Parchment paper	Use as a cover to prevent splattering or a wrap for steaming.
Plastic	Microwave-safe only. Follow the manufacturer's instructions. Should be labeled "Microwave Safe". Some plastic containers soften, as the food inside gets hot. "Boiling bags" and tightly closed plastic bags should be slit, pierced or vented as directed by package.

Wood	Wood will dry out when used in the microwave oven and may split or crack.



SETTING UP YOUR OVEN


Names of Oven Parts and Accessories

Remove the oven and all materials from the carton and oven cavity.

Your oven comes with the following accessories:



Turntable Installation



- a. Never place the glass tray upside down. Follow the instruction to place the glass tray on the turntable ring with correct direction. The glass tray should rotate smoothly.
- b. Both glass tray and turntable ring assembly must always be used during cooking.
- c. All food and containers of food are always placed on the glass tray for cooking.
- d. If glass tray or turntable ring assembly cracks or breaks, contact your nearest authorized service center.

Countertop Installation


Remove all packing material and accessories. Examine the oven for any damage such as dents or broken door. Do not install if oven is damaged.

Cabinet: Remove any protective film found on the microwave oven cabinet surface.

Do not remove the light brown Mica cover that is attached to the oven cavity to protect the magnetron.

Installation

1. Select a level surface that provide enough open space for the intake and/or outlet vents.



- (1) The minimum installation height is 85cm.
- (2) The rear surface of appliance shall be placed against a wall.

 Leave a minimum clearance of 30cm above the oven, a minimum clearance of 20cm is required between the oven and any adjacent walls.
- (3) Do not remove the legs from the bottom of the oven.
- (4) Blocking the intake and/ or outlet openings can damage the oven.
- (5) Place the oven as far away from radios and TV as possible. Operation of microwave oven may cause interference to your radio or TV reception.
- 2. Plug your oven into a standard household outlet. Be sure the voltage and the frequency is the same as the voltage and the frequency on the rating label.

WARNING: Do not install oven over a range cooktop or other heat-producing appliance. If installed near or over a heat source, the oven could be damaged and the warranty would be void.

The accessible surface may be hot during operation.

OPERATION

1. Clock Setting

When the microwave oven is electrified, the screen will display "0:00", buzzer will ring once.

- 1) Press "KITCHEN TIMER/ CLOCK" twice to select clock function, the hour figures will flash.
- 2) Turn " to adjust the hour figures, the input time should be within 0--23.
- 3) Press " START/+30SEC.", the minute figures will flash.
- 4) Turn " to adjust the minute figures, the input time should be within 0--59.
- 5) Press "START/+30SEC. " to finish clock setting. ":" will flash, and the time will light.
- 6) If need to reset the clock, please repeat the step1 to step 5.

Note: 1) If the clock is not set, it would not function when powered.

2) During the process of clock setting, if you press " **STOP/CANCEL**" or if there is no operation in 1minute, the oven will go back to the previous status automatically.

2. Microwave Cooking

Press "MICROWAVE" once, the screen will display "800w" and "00:00" is light. Press "MICROWAVE" repeatedly or turn " to choose the power you want, and "800w", "600w", "400w", "200w", "100w" will display for each added press. Then press "START/+30SEC." to confirm, and turn " to set cooking time from 0:05 to 95:00. Press "START/+30SEC." again to start cooking.

Example: If you want to use 600W microwave power to cook for 20 minutes, you can operate the oven as the following steps.

- 1) Press " MICROWAVE " once, the screen displays "800w".
- 2) Press "MICROWAVE" once again or turn " or to choose 600W microwave power.
- 3) Press "START/+30SEC." to confirm, and the screen displays "600w".
- 4) Turn " " to adjust the cooking time until the oven displays "20:00".
- 5) Press "START/+30SEC." to start cooking.

Note: the step quantities for the adjustment time of the coding switch are as follow:

3. Grill or Combi. Cooking

Press "GRILL/COMBI" once, the screen will display "G". Press "GRILL/COMBI" repeatedly or turn " to choose the power you want, and "G", "C1". "C2" will display for each added press. Then press "START/+30SEC." to confirm, and turn " to set cooking time from 0:05 to 95:00. Press " START/+30SEC. " again to start cooking.

Example: If you want to use 55% microwave power and 45% grill power(C1) to cook for 10 minutes, you can operate the oven as the following steps.

- 1) Press " GRILL/COMBI " once, the screen displays "G".
- 2) Press " GRILL/COMBI " for times or turn " v to choose combi. 1 mode.
- 3) Press " START/+30SEC. " to confirm, and the screen displays "C1".
- 4) Turn " or to adjust the cooking time until the oven displays "10:00".
- 5) Press " START/+30SEC. " to start cooking.

4. Quick Start (Recommended heating accessories: Container for microwave covered with cap or plastic wrap)

- 1) In multi-stage cooking state, each press of " START/+30SEC. " can increase 30 seconds cooking time. Defrosting stage cannot increase time.
- 2) In microwave, grill, combination cooking or time defrost state, each press of "START/+30SEC." can increase 30 seconds of cooking time.
- 3) In waiting state, turn " "left to set cooking time with 100% microwave power, "800w" is light, and "00:00" will flash. Then turn " "left or right to set cooking time (or press" START/+30SEC. " to set 30 seconds of cooking time and the oven start cooking automatically). After choosing the cooking time, press "START/+30SEC." to start cooking.

5. Defrost By Time (Recommended heating accessories: Container for microwave)

- 1) Press " **DEFROST**" once, and the oven will display the defrost power "240w" and "00:00" will flash to remind you input the defrost time.
- 2) Turn " or select the defrost time. The MAX time is 95 minutes.
- 3) Press " START/+30SEC." to start defrosting. The defrost power cannot be changed.

6. Defrost By Weight (Recommended heating accessories: Container for microwave)

- 1) Press " DEFROST " twice, and "100" will flash to remind you input the defrost weight.
- 2) Turn " To select the weight of food from 100 to 1500 g.
- 3) Press " START/+30SEC. " to start defrosting.

7. Kitchen Timer

- 1) Press "KITCHEN TIMER / CLOCK" once, the screen will display 00:00.
- 2) Turn " to enter the correct time. (The maximum cooking time is 95 minutes.)
- 3) Press " START/+30SEC. " to confirm setting.
- 4) When the kitchen time is reached, the buzzer will ring 5 times and "End" will display on the screen.

Note:1) The Kitchen timer is for you to count down the cooking time, when the cooking is not doing by the oven.

- 2) The inquiry of current time cannot work when the kitchen timer is working.
- 3) During the working of kitchen timer, press" STOP/CANCEL " can cancel the kitchen timer and the oven go back to waiting state.

8. Auto Menu

- 1) Turn " right to choose the menu, and "A-1" to "A-12" will display.
- 2) Press " START/+30SEC. " to confirm.
- 3) Turn " " to choose the default weight as the menu chart.
- 4) Press " START/+30SEC. " to start cooking.

Example: If you want to use "Auto Menu" to cook pasta for 100g.

- 1) Turn " clockwise till "A-6" displays.
- 2) Press " START/+30SEC. " to confirm.
- 3) Turn " or to select the weight of pasta till "100" displays.
- 4) Press " START/+30SEC. " to start cooking.

9. Multi-stage cooking (Recommended heating accessories: Container for microwave)

At most 2 sections can be set for cooking. In multi-stage cooking, if one section is defrosting, then defrosting shall be placed in the first section automatically.

Note: Kitchen timer and auto menu cannot work in multi-stage cooking. Quick start can be set as one of sections in multi-stage cooking.

Example: If you want to defrost food for 5 minutes and then cook with 600W microwave power for 7 minutes, operate it as the following:

- 1) Press "DEFROST" once, and the oven will display "240W" and "00:00" will flash.
- 2) Turn " or to select the defrost time till "5:00" displays.
- 3) Press " MICROWAVE " once, the screen displays "800W".
- 4) Press " **MICROWAVE** " once again or turn " " to choose 600W microwave power.
- 5) Press " START/+30SEC. " to confirm, and the screen displays "600W".
- 6) Turn " " to adjust the cooking time till the oven displays "7:00".
- 7) Press "START/+30SEC." to start cooking, and buzzer will sound once for the first section, defrosting time counts down. Buzzer will sound once again entering the second cooking. When cooking finishes, buzzer sounds five times.

10. Inquiring Function

In cooking state, press "KITCHEN TIMER /CLOCK" to inquire the time and the time will display for 3 seconds.

Lock quitting: In locked state, press "STOP/CANCEL" for 3 seconds, there will be a long "beep" denoting that the lock is released.

12. Turntable Reset Function

When cooking finished, if the turntable is not at the initial position, it will enter the turntable reset function. At this time, the lamp, fan and turntable are working," [" will dynamic display. After the turntable has reset, the screen will display "End" to remind cooking is finished.

Note:

- 1. This function only works for one completed cooking. If pause or open the oven door during cooking, the current cooking cannot enter the turntable reset function.
- 2. Under the reset state, opening the door or "STOP/CANCEL" button is pressed, the oven will go back to waiting state.
- 3. Position Precision: cooking time in 5 minutes and turntable degrees within the range of minus 30 degrees to 30 degrees.
