The product is intended only for home use and for textiles in household amounts suitable for washing or drying. This appliance is for indoor use only and not intended for built in use. Only use according to these instructions. The appliance is not intended for commercial use.

Any other use is considered as improper use. The producer is not responsible for any damage or injury that may result from it.

This appliance is intended to be used in household only and it is not intended to be used such as:

- Staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments;
- Farm houses;
- By clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments;
- Bed and breakfast type environments;
- Areas for communal use in blocks of flats or in launderettes.

Electric Shock Hazard

- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- If the machine is damaged, it must not be operated unless repaired by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons.
- Do not climb or sit on the appliance.
- Before plugging in this product, ensure that the connection parameter on the rating plate (fuse rating, voltage and frequency) match the mains electricity supply. If in any doubt, consult a qualified electrician.
- Do not pull the power cord forcefully. Please grasp the mains plug instead.

- Do not plug/unplug the mains plug with wet hands.
- The accessibility of the plug must always be ensured, in order to disconnect the tumble dryer from the mains.

- Do not lean on the opened door of this product.
- Condensed water is not drinking water. It can cause health problems in both people and animals if consumed.

Danger of Damage

- Do not put more load than rated in this user manual. See the related chapter in the user manual.
- Do not operate the dryer without the door filter.
- Do not dry the clothes before being spin.
- Do not expose the dryer directly under the sun.
- While cleaning and maintenance, please do remember to unpulg and do not directly spray the dryer with water.
- The appliance should not be overturned during normal use or maintenance.

Explosion & Fire Danger

- Please do not dry the clothes with any flammable substances such as kerosene or alcohol. Otherwise, there may be explosion.
- Keep away from open flame and other sources of ignition.
- This product is not to be used if industrial chemicals have been used for cleaning.
- Do not dry unwashed items in the tumble dryer.
- Items that have been soiled with substances such as cooking oil, acetone, alcohol, petrol, kerosene, spot removers, turpentine, waxes and wax removers should be washed in hot water with an extra amount of detergent before being dried in the tumble dryer.
- Items such as foam rubber (latex foam), shower caps, waterproof textiles, rubber backed articles and clothes or pillows fitted with foam rubber pads should not be dried in the tumble dryer.
- Fabric softeners, or similar products, should be used as specified by the fabric softener instructions.
- Oil-affected items can ignite spontaneously, especially when exposed to heat sources such as in a tumble dryer. The items become warm, causing an oxidation reaction in the oil. Oxidation creates heat. If the heat cannot escape, the items can become hot enough to catch fire. Piling, stacking or storing oil-affected items can prevent heat from escaping and so create a fire hazard.

- Remove all objects from pockets such as lighters and matches.
- If it is unavoidable that fabrics that contain vegetable or cooking oil or have been contaminated by hair care products be placed in a tumble dryer they should first be washed in hot water with extra detergent. This will reduce, but not eliminate, the hazard.
- Never stop a tumble dryer before the end of the drying cycle unless all items are quickly removed and spread out so that the heat is dissipated.
- Openings must not be obstructed.
- The lint trap has to be cleaned frequently.
- Lint must not to be allowed to accumulate around the tumble dryer.
- WARNING: Do not damage the refrigerant circuit.
- WARNING: In the appliance enclosure or in the built-in structure, keep ventilation openings clear of obstruction.

Safety with Children

- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8
 years and above and persons with reduced physical,
 sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and
 knowledge if they have been given supervision or
 instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe
 way and understand the hazards involved.
- Children shall not play with the appliance.
- Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be done by children without supervision.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Children of less than 3 years should be kept away unless continuously supervised.
- Always close the door after use. In this way you will avoid the danger of:
 - 1. Children climbing onto or into the dryer or hiding thing in it.

- 2. Pets or other small animals climbing into it.
- Glass door may become very hot during the operation.
 Keep children and pets far away from the machine while it is operating.

Installation Location and Surrounding

- All washing and additional substances are to be kept in a safe place out of the reach of children.
- Do not install the machine on a carpet floor.
- The obstruction of the openings by a carpet can damage the machine.
- Keep the appliance clear from heating sources and direct sunlight to avoid plastic and rubber parts to corrode.
- Do not use the appliance in humid environments or rooms containing explosive or caustic gas. In case of water leakage or water splashes, let the appliance dry in the open air.
- The appliance must not be installed behind a lockable door, a sliding door or a door with a hinge on the opposite side to that of the machine.
- Do not operate the machine in rooms with a temperature of below 2°C. This can cause damages to parts of it. For example, in the dryer unit, there is a risk of damage if condensed water is allowed to freeze in the pump and hoses. If it is unavoidable, make sure to drain the water completely from the appliance after every use (see "MAINTENANCE -Cleaning the Drain Pump Filter") to avoid damages caused by frost.
- Never use flammable sprays or substances in the immediate proximity of the appliance.

Installation

 Remove all packaging material and transport bolts before using the appliance. Otherwise, serious damage may result.

- This appliance is equipped with a single inlet valve and can be connected to the cold water supply only.
- Mains plug must be accessible after installation.
- Before washing the clothes at first time, the product shall be operated one round of the whole procedures without the clothes inside. The suggested program is "DRUM CLEAN".
- Before using the machine, the product shall be calibrated.
- Do not put any excessively heavy objects on the appliance, like water containers or heating devices.
- The new hose-sets supplied with the appliance are to be used and that old hose-sets should not be reused.
- Max. Inlet water pressure 1 MPa. Min. inlet water pressure 0.05 Mpa.
- Ensure the appliance is placed completely level and securely positioned on a solid, flat surface.
- The appliance must remain stable under load and should not seesaw — that is, rock back and forth — at its corners.

- Children can become entangled in the packaging film or swallow small parts and suffocate. Do not allow children to play with the packaging.
- The appliance must not be installed behind a lockable door, a sliding door or a door with a hinge on the opposite side to that of the tumble dryer, in such a way that a full opening of the tumble dryer door is restricted.
- Do not restrict the floor clearance through deep pile carpets, strips of wood or similar. This might cause heat built-up which would interfere with the operation of the appliance.

Electrical Connection

 Make sure the supply cable is not trapped by the machine, or it can get damaged.

- Connect the product to a grounded outlet protected by a fuse complying with the values in the "Technical specifications" table. The grounding installation has to be made by a qualified electrician. Ensure that the machine is installed in accordance with the local regulations.
- Water and electrical connections must be carried out by a qualified technician in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and local safety regulations.

⚠Warning!

- Do not connect the appliance to the mains electricity supply by an extension lead multi-socket adapter or similar.
- The appliance must not have an external switching device such as a timer or connected to a circuit that is regularly switched on and off.
- Do not pull the plug out of the mains outlet if there is flammable gas around.
- Never pull out power plug with wet hands.
- Always pull at the plug, not at the cable.
- Always unplug the appliance if it is not being used.
- Do not bend, clamp or damage the power cord and the power plug.
- The appliance must not be supplied through an external switching device, such as a timer, or connected to a circuit that is regularly switched on and off by a utility.
- Do not connect the appliance to the mains electricity supply by an extension lead, multi-socket adapter or similar.

Water Connections

- Check the connections of the water inlet tubes, the water tap and the outlet hose for possible problems due to changes of water pressure. If the connections loosen or leak, close the water tap and get it repaired.
- Do not use the appliance before the pipes and hoses are installed properly by qualified persons.
- The water inlet and outlet hoses have to be safely installed and remain undamaged.
- Otherwise, water leakage can occur.
- Do not remove the drain pump filter while there is still water in the appliance. Big quantities of water can leak out, and there is a risk of scalding due to hot water.

Operation and Maintenance

- Never use any flammable, explosive or toxic solvents. Do not use gasoline and alcohol etc. as detergents. Only select detergents that are suitable for machine washing.
- Make sure that all pockets are emptied. Sharp and rigid items such as coins, brooches, nails, screws, stones etc. may cause serious damages to this machine.
- Thoroughly rinse items that have been washed by hand.
- Fabric softeners or similar products should be used are recommended in their instructions.
- Never try to open the door forcefully.
- The door of the washing machine will unlock shortly after the end of a cycle.
- Please do not close the door with excessive force. If it is found difficult to close the door, please check if the clothes are properly inserted and distributed.
- Always unplug the appliance and close the water tap before cleaning and maintenance and after each use.

- Never pour water over the appliance for cleaning purpose.
- Repairs shall only be carried out by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- The producer will not be responsible for damages caused by the intervention of not authorized persons.

Transport

- •Before Transport:
 - -Never transport the upper and lower dryer units and the washing unit jointed; always transport each unit seperately.
 - -Bolts shall be reinstalled to the machine by a specialized person;
 - -Accumulated water shall be drained out of the machine.
- This appliance is heavy, so transport with care. Never hold any protruding part of the machine when lifting. The machine door can not be used as a handle.
- Move cautiously. Do not grasp any salient parts of machine. The machine door cannot be used as the handle for transport. If the dryer can't be transported erectly, the dryer can be tilted to right less than 30°.
- When transporting the product, do not transport it in a horizontal position. If long-distance transportation or machine disassembly is required, please contact the local service provider.

Risk of injury and damage!

Improper handling of the appliance may result in injury.

 The appliance is very heavy. Never transport or carry the appliance alone; always with the assistance of another person.

- Remove all obstacles on the transport route and from the installation location, e.g. open doors and clear away objects lying on the floor.
- Remove all package material before using the appliance.
- Before setting up this product, check it for any externally visible damage. Do not install or use a damaged product.

UV Radiation Safety

- This warning only covers products which contain a UV-C lamp and which have a disinfection function with UV-C lamp.
- The device contains a lamp that emits UV-C rays.
 Do not look at the source of light while the lamp is operating!










■ Installation

Installation Area


- Stability is important to prevent the product from wandering!
- Make sure the machine is standing leveled and stable.
- Make sure that the product does not stand onto the power cord.
- Make sure to maintain the minimum distances as shown in the picture.



Before installing the machine, the location characterized as follows shall be selected:

- 1. Rigid, dry, and level surface.
- 2.Avoid direct sunlight.
- 3.Sufficient ventilation.
- 4. Room temperature is above 2 $^{\circ}\text{C}$.
- 5. Keep far away from the heat sources such as coal or gas burning appliances.

Unpacking the Machine



🔍 Warning!

- Packaging material (e.g. Films, Styrofoam) can be dangerous for children.
- There is a risk of suffocation! Keep all packaging well away from children.
- 1. Remove the cardboard box and styrofoam
- 2. Lift the machine and remove the base packaging.
- 3. Remove the tape securing the power supply cord and drain hose.
- 4. Remove the inlet hose from the drum.
- 5.Remove the decorative strips from the top of the packing foam.


Remove Transport Bolts




/N Warning!

You must remove the transport bolts from the backside before using the product.

- 1. Loosen the 4 transport bolts with a spanner.
- 2. Remove the bolts including the rubber parts and keep them for future use.



3. Close the holes using the cover caps.



Levelling the Machine



The lock nuts on all four feet must be screwed tightly against the housing.



- 1. Loosen the lock nut.
- 2. Turn the foot until it reaches the floor.
- 3. Adjust the legs and lock the nuts with a spanner. Make sure the machine is level using a spirit level.

Connect the Water Supply Hose




To prevent leakage or water damage, follow the instructions in this chapter.

• Do not kink, crush or modify water inlet hose.



Connect the water supply hose to the water inlet valve and a water tap with cold water as indicated.



Note!

• Connect manually, do not use tools. Check if the connections are tight.






Installation steps:




The whole machine requires two professionals for installation.



1.Lift the dryer onto the drum washing machine, leaving a distance of 10-20cm at the front to facilitate the insertion of the terminal through the small hole at the top. Place the power cord and signal cord of the dryer into the waterproof box (as shown in the figure), complete the connection of the drum terminals, and fasten the waterproof box. Next, drive one screw (ST4*14) on the left side of the decorative component of the drum control panel to fix and complete the installation.




2.After stacking the machines neatly and ensuring that the holes of the dryer and the drum are aligned, attach the two fixing plates (sheet metal parts) from the accessory bag to the left and right sides of the bottom of the dryer as shown in the diagram. Secure them by driving two screws (ST4*14) into each fixing plate to secure the machine.



3. Install the left and right decorative strips, securing each side with three screws (ST4*14) to fix the machine (the left and right decorative strips are on the foam top cover of the washing machine packaging box). On one side, use the drain pipe clamp from the accessory assembly to clip onto the drum drain pipe and secure it with a screw on the decorative strip. Finally, use two screws (ST4*14) to secure the tee on the top cover of the drum. After completion, install the dryer drain pipe connector to complete the installation.

Drain Hose





<u>∕</u> Warning!

- · Do not kink or protract the drain hose.
- Position drain hose properly, otherwise damage might result of water leakage.

There are two ways to place the end of drain hose:


- Put it into the drain port. If the drain hose is put into the drain hole on the floor, fix the drain hose on the back of the appliance to prevent water overflow from the drum.
- 2. Connect it to the branch drain hose of the trough.

- Do not let the drain pipe be compressed by heavy objects or deformed under force, as this
 may affect drainage.
- After professional installation and drainage completion, users should not adjust the height of the drain pipe on their own.
- Do not remove the drain pipe fixing clamp, as unauthorized removal may cause machine malfunction.
- Do not excessively bend the drain pipe or hang it in a U-shape over the sink.



∠!\ Caution! ·

- If the drain pipe is too long, do not force it into the sewer, you can cut off the excess length.
- Please be cautious when excising the drainage pipe to avoid injuries.



Diagram of excising the drainage pipe


If the drain pipe is not long enough, please contact vour local service center.

Drying Support Installation

The following drying support is optional for specific models.

If your dryer has following parts, please wear gloves to install them as per the instruction below.

If you want to install the drying support, first clamp the support on the door filter, then hook it in the front support slot(as shown below).



₽ Note!

Drying support is mainly used for items that are not suitable for tumble dry, like hats, shoes, plush toys etc. Warm program is recommended for this function and if items are not completely dried once, you can restart the program to complete drying. All items dried with support must meet the warning requirements of page 6. Leather products also cannot be dried.




Caution!

- Before washing, please make sure the machine is installed properly.
- Your appliance was thoroughly checked before it left the factory. To remove any
 residual water and to neutralize potential odors, it's recommended to clean your
 appliance before first use. For this reason, recommended to clean the inner drum by
 running the "DRUM CLEAN" or other program with the optional temperature of 90°C. Be
 careful not to put laundry and detergent in the machine.

Before Each Washing


- The ambient temperature of the machine should be 5°C-40°C. If used under 0°C, the inlet valve and draining system may be damaged. If the machine is installed under freezing conditions, it should be transferred to normal ambient temperature to ensure the water supply hose and drain hose can unfreeze before use.
- Please check your laundry care labels and the detergent use instructions before wash. Use non-foaming or less-foaming detergent suitable for machine properly.
 - Take all items out of the pockets






Warning!

- Do not wash articles that have been cleaned in, washed in, soaked in, or dabbed with combustible or explosive substances like wax, oil, paint, gasoline, alcohol, kerosene, and other flammable materials.
- Washing single clothes items may easily create big eccentricity. Therefore it is suggested
 to add one or two more laundry items to the wash so that spin can be done smoothly.
- Do not wash, spin water-proof seats, mats, or clothing.

Detergent Dispenser

№ Note!

- The detergent box of this model is automatically dispensed with laundry detergent, which can store a certain amount of laundry detergent without having to add it every time;
- Please put the detergent directly into the washing cylinder with the clothes, do not
 put it in the detergent box, so as not to block the inlet, when using the laundry
 pods, please turn off the automatic delivery;
- For clumpy and viscous detergents or additives, it is recommended to dilaute them with a small amount of water before pouring them into the detergent cartridge;
- Please choose the correct inlet for delivery, incorrect delivery may lead to foam residue and unclean laundry;
- Please turn on the detergent box after it is installed, and do not open the detergent box when the machine is running to prevent water or foam from overflowing.



AUTODOSE

- 1. Please choose a low-foaming laundry detergent, as high foaming can easily cause rinsing and unclean, or foam overflow and leakage;
- 2. Particularly viscous laundry detergent, it is recommended to dilute it according to the actual situation;
- 3. When the power is on, when the washing machine is turned on, it will automatically detect the residual amount of laundry detergent, if the laundry detergent indicator flashes, it means that the residual amount of laundry detergent in the automatic box is insufficient, please unscrew the lid and add laundry detergent;
- 4. After adding the laundry detergent, be sure to tighten the lid well.

II SINGAL DOSE

- 1. This inlet is a manual inlet, please put the amount of laundry detergent required for this washing;
- 2. When putting laundry detergent or other detergent into this inlet, please turn off the automatic dispensing, and add the appropriate amount of laundry detergent or detergent, and confirm whether it is high foaming or concentrated type, adding too much will cause foam overflow and leakage, trigger the defoaming program to increase the running time;
- 3. When using the high-temperature cylinder for self-cleaning, the machine will be turned off by default and automatically put in, please do not manually add detergent or laundry detergent, such as when using special cleaning agent, pay attention to the manufacturer's instructions and dosage:
- 4. If you need to use a clothing disinfectant, you can put it in this inlet, please refer to the instructions and dosage of the disinfectant manufacturer when using.





• Do not put in the detergent cartridge to avoid clogging the inlet and causing water leakage.

Laundry pods or tablets should be placed directly into the washing drum with the laundry.

SOFTNER


- 1. The washing machine will put the fabric softener in the last rinse stage, so be sure not to put laundry detergent in this tank;
- 2. The softener is put through the siphon principle, please do not put powdered fixing lotion in this tank to avoid blockage failure, if there is agglomeration, please remove it in time;
- 3. The fabric softener can neutralize the residue of laundry detergent and powder to a certain extent, but please do not exceed the MAX marking line to avoid being unable to put it.

■ Before Each Drying

Note!

- Leave it to stand for 2 hours after transporting. Before first use, please use
 the soft fabric to clean the inside drum.
 - 1. Put some clean rags into the drum.
 - 2.Plug the power, select the [TIME DRY] program, press [▷□] button.
 - 3. After finishing this program, please follow the "Cleaning and Care" to clean the door filter.
- During drying, the compressor and the water will generate some noise which is entirely normal.
- 1.Before drying, thoroughly spin the laundry in washing machine. High spin speed shortens the drying time and saves energy.
- 2. For uniform drying result, sort the laundry according to fabric type and select the appropriate drying program.
- 3. Before drying, please close zips, hooks and eyelets, button, tie fabric belts, etc.
- 4. Remove all objects from pockets such as lighters and matches.
- 5. Remove underwiring from bras.
- 6.Close duvet covers and pillow cases to prevent small items from being rolled up inside them.

- 10. Keep the area around the tumble dryer clean. Coal dust or flour may cause an explosion.
- 11. The door shall be opened only after the program of the tumble dryer is finished to avoid being scalded by hot steam or over heated drying machine.
- 12.Clean the lint filter and empty water container after each use to avoid extension of drying time and increase of energy consumption.
- $13. Do \ not \ dry \ clothes \ after \ dry-clean \ process.$

Cleaning and Care

• Always unplug the appliance and close the water tap before cleaning and maintenance.

Cleaning the Cabinet

Proper maintenance on the machine can extend its working life. The surface can be cleaned with diluted non-abrasive neutral detergents when necessary. If there is any water overflow, use a towel to wipe it off immediately. Never use sharp items to clean the appliance.

 Never use abrasive or caustic agents. Such as formic acids or its diluted solvents or similar substances, like alcohol or chemical products.


Note!

• The dryer does not shut off instantly when remote control is paused/aborted. It is a normal operation, not a fault, because cooling in progress-the dryer will shut off automatically when cooled.

Emergency door

In case of power outage or other situations where the door cannot be opened normally and needs to be opened, please pull down the emergency door opening rope.

After opening the door, please restore the emergency door opening rope.



Unplug the power plug, lightly press the filter door to automatically pop out



Please drain the water before opening the emergency door. Only when the water level in the upper cylinder is lower than the clothing input port in the lower cylinder can the emergency door be opened



Pull down on the emergency opening rope of the corresponding cylinder to emergency open the door of the washing machine






- Before operation, please turn off the power and unplug the power plug.
- Do not use this drawstring during normal washing. In case of emergency use, it is recommended to drain the water level below the mouth of the washing machine barrel and wait for the water to cool before opening it to avoid the risk of burns caused by excessive residual water in the barrel and high temperature flowing out.

Freezing and anti freezing treatment

The optimal operating environment for this machine is (2-40) °C. If used in an environment below 2 °C, it may damage the waterway system; If the machine has just returned to an indoor environment of 2 °C or below, it should be left to stand for a day until the ice melts before use.
